

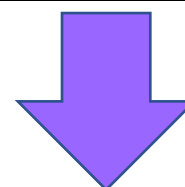
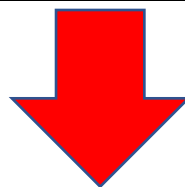
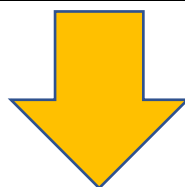
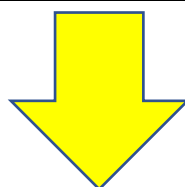


### MY INDEPENDENT LEARNING TIME (MIL TIME) PROJECTS
